If you haven't been to a National Gathering at Taurewa before, you may be wondering what to expect. Taurewa Lodge is a basic but comfortable school camp with a communal kitchen, living, and dining room in the main building, and separate accommodation in small cabins for one or two people, dormitory-style bunkrooms, and a cottage – which is ideal for older or less physically able people.

Expect:

- Opening circle on Friday night to start the gathering
- An opening circle each morning
- Live our culture of caring community with self-direction
- Sessions
- Requests for workshops and offers of workshops culminating in a timetable of workshops
- Various exploration activities such as nature walks, hot pools, waterfalls, Chateau visit etc
- Healthy food that is joyfully prepared and shared together

Children of Co-Counsellors are welcome to attend. The Gathering will be drug and alcohol-free.

We encourage Co-Counsellors from around New Zealand to attend this Winter Gathering.

The cost for the 3-day weekend is \$72 per person for the huts or \$108 pp for cottage accommodation.

Plus we each bring food to share for the weekend.



What to bring:

You'll need to bring:

Warm clothes for evenings, good walking shoes, bedding/good sleeping bag, a raincoat, and togs may be useful.

Food: for breakfast, plus items to prepare two shared lunches and two shared main meals.

If you have special dietary needs, bring your food labeled so that it will be reserved for you. You may also like to bring songbooks, musical instruments, music and art equipment.

A woollen blanket for the top of the very firm plastic covered mattresses is good for insulation under sleeping bags.

Some people pop in a heater as the installed fixed wall heaters are on timers or bring your hottie (bottle).

Taurewa Directions and contact:

The actual Camp landline is (07) 386 5835

If you are travelling to Taurewa for the first time and are unable to carpool, let someone know your travel plans as it can be tricky to find. The last service station is Turangi so fill up there or Waiouru from the South.

GPS signal can be patchy from Turangi.

GPS for Pukehinau Rd:

Tongariro Forest Park 3989 -39.077202, 175.558474. This is about one km past Mangatepopo Camp on the right.

Camp co-ordinates: The actual co-ordinates are: -39.079802, 175.554403 Keep left on the Pukehinau Rd which will take you to Taurewa which has the Hillary/Taurewa signpost.

From the North: Turn right into State Highway 41 just after Turangi 2.5km Turn left onto SH 47. Travel about 26.5 km. Destination is on the right just past Mangatepopo School Camp. **From the South:** Take Highway 46 and turn left onto SH 47 and travel 26.5 km. There are often balloons on the sign.
